CALL FOR MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION  
FOR THE CITY OF FORT OGLETHORPE

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with O.C.G.A. 21-2-132 and O.C.G.A. 21-2-9 (c) a municipal general election will be held for the City of Fort Oglethorpe on Tuesday, November 4, 2025, at the City of Fort Oglethorpe located at 500 City Hall Dr., Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Qualifying for the municipal general election shall be held at the Freedom Center located at 5238 Evitt St., Ringgold, Georgia, beginning at 8:30 a.m. on Monday, August 18, 2025, and ending at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 20, 2025. The hours of qualifying will be 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Monday and 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday and Wednesday.

**\*Three (3) Council Members (Ward 2, Ward 3, and Ward 5) are up for election and the Qualifying fee is \$255.00.**

Early voting will begin on Tuesday, October 14, 2025, and will end on Friday, October 31, 2025. Voting hours are:

Monday – Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Saturday voting will be October 18, 2025, and October 25, 2025, from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Extended hours will be held Thursday Oct. 30, 2025, from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

To request an absentee ballot by mail, contact the Catoosa County Board of Elections and Voter Registration Office at 706-935-3990. The last day to request an absentee ballot by mail is October 24, 2025.

The last day to register to vote for the municipal general election is Monday, October 6, 2025.
